He is Adjunct Clinical Professor of Dermatology at the Touro University of College of Osteopathic Medicine in Henderson, Nevada and has the distinction of being the first and only dermatology residency program director in the history of the state of Nevada. Prior to coming to Las Vegas, Dr. Del Rosso served as Head of the Section of Dermatology at the Ohio University College of Osteopathic Medicine in Athens, and Visiting Faculty Member in Dermatology at Ohio State University (OSU) in Columbus where he twice was honored as Educator of the Year by the dermatology residents. He received his D.O. degree from Ohio University College of Osteopathic Medicine, interned at Doctors Hospital in Columbus, completed a dermatology residency at Atlantic Skin Disease and Skin Surgery in Fort Lauderdale, Florida, and a fellowship in Mohs micrographic surgery and cutaneous oncology at OSU. He has just been reappointed to another full 4 year term. He also serves as the Associate Editor of the Journal of Clinical & Aesthetic Dermatology and Pigment International. He has given over 100+ lectures nationally and internationally, and is passionate about advocacy and advancement of our specialty. He is married and has one daughter and one son.

ZOE DIANA DRAELOS, MD

Zoe Diana Draelos, MD, is a research and clinical board-certified dermatologist and a Fellow of the American Academy of Dermatology. She is in solo private practice in High Point, North Carolina, and an Adjunct Assistant Professor of Dermatology at Duke University. In 1988, she founded Dermatology Consulting Services, PLLC, to initiate and perform research in aging skin, acne, rosacea, psoriasis, atopic dermatitis, actinic keratoses, eczema, and aesthetic procedures in the cosmetic, OTC drug, and pharmaceutical arenas. Prior to pursuing a medical career, Dr. Draelos completed an undergraduate degree in Mechanical Engineering and was elected a Rhodes Scholar. A member of Sigma Xi research honorary and Alpha Omega Alpha medical honorary, she is author of 14 books including *Cosmetics in Dermatology and Hair Cosmetics*. She is the editor of *Cosmetic Dermatology: Products and Procedures and Cosmeceuticals*, both in their third edition with translations into 7 languages. She has contributed chapters to 44 textbooks, written 120 posters, served as the principle investigator on 862 studies, written 612 published papers, delivered 360 oral presentations, served on or contributed to 38 journal editorial boards, functioned as the editor-in-chief of the *Journal of Cosmetic Dermatology* for 10 years, and was a past member of the Board of Directors of the American Academy of Dermatology and the American Society for Dermatologic Surgery. She was elected Vice-President of the American Academy of Dermatology. She is recognized as a pioneer in cosmetic dermatology and received a lifetime achievement award from Health Beauty America for her research and the 2008 DermArts award for her contributions to dermatology. In 2010, she received the Albert Kligman Innovation Award and in 2016 she was awarded a Presidential Citation from the American Academy of Dermatology for her research contributions to advance the specialty. She received the prestigious Maison deNavarre award from the Society of Cosmetic Chemists for her contributions to the art and science of cosmetics in 2017. In 2019, she was the inaugural recipient of the Florence Wall Award from the Society of Cosmetics Chemists honoring her as the most influential woman in cosmetic science.

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MICHAEL H. GOLD, MD

Dr. Michael H. Gold is the founder and medical director of Gold Skin Care Center, Advanced Aesthetics Medical Spa, The Laser & Rejuvenation Center, and Tennessee Clinical Research Center in Nashville, TN. He is a board-certified dermatologist and dermatologic surgeon and oversees the various facets of the center's operations — a combination of medical and surgical dermatology, cosmetic dermatology, aesthetic services and research endeavors, which began in 1990. The Tennessee Clinical Research Center is regarded in the industry as one of the best clinical research centers for medical dermatology and aesthetic/cosmetic research endeavors — focusing on FDA Phase II, III, and IV clinical trials.

Dr. Gold has earned worldwide recognition for providing patients with leading-edge technological advances in dermatology and aesthetic skin care. He plays an integral role in the development of new pharmaceutical products, injectable fillers and toxins, skin care, and medical devices through his clinical research practice. He presents results of his work regularly at national and international dermatology, plastic surgical, and cosmetic meetings.

Dr. Gold has authored over 500 published scientific articles, 40 textbook chapters, has edited two textbooks on Photodynamic Therapy as well as been Senior Editor on textbooks on Microneedling as well as Cosmeceuticals & Skin Care. He serves on most major dermatology journal scientific boards and is the current Editor-in-Chief of the Journal of Cosmetic Dermatology and the Editor-in-Chief of Dermatological Reviews. In addition, Dr. Gold helped establish the SCALE meeting in Nashville — now entering its 17th year - it is one of the leading U.S. dermatologic and aesthetic meetings.

Dr. Gold also helped start two international groups: the Dermatologic Aesthetic Surgery International League (DASIL), which aims to create a global community for the open exchange of knowledge and innovation by physicians specializing in dermatology, dermatologic surgery, and aesthetic surgery. It has become one of the most prominent and important international dermatology groups. It show cases meetings all over the world; and the 5-Continent-Congress (5CC), one of the world's leading conferences on dermatology and aesthetic/cosmetic medicine, where he is the current President of the Congress.

PETER LIO, MD

Peter Lio, MD is a Clinical Assistant Professor of Dermatology & Pediatrics at Northwestern University Feinberg School of Medicine. Dr. Lio received his medical degree from Harvard Medical School, completed his internship in Pediatrics at Boston Children's Hospital, and his Dermatology training at Harvard where he served as Chief Resident in Dermatology. While at Harvard, he received formal training in acupuncture. Dr. Lio is the founding director of the Chicago Integrative Eczema Center and a founding partner of Medical Dermatology Associates of Chicago. He currently serves as a board member and scientific advisory committee member for the National Eczema Association. He is a member of the American Academy of Dermatology's Atopic Dermatitis Expert Resource Group and a founding faculty member of the Integrative Dermatology Certificate Program. He has over 200 publications and 3 textbooks.

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MARY R. LUPO, MD

Dr. Mary P. Lupo is a board certified dermatologist, clinical professor of dermatology at Tulane University School of Medicine and an internationally recognized innovator in non-surgical skin rejuvenation. In 1983, as chief resident of dermatology at Tulane Health Science Center, she added cosmetic injectable therapy, sclerotherapy and chemical peels to the core curriculum of training for Tulane residents. This resident cosmetic clinic continues to this day. As a frequent member of advisory boards and as an investigator in FDA clinical trials, she has impacted the development and improvement of non-surgical treatments such as neuromodulation, dermal fillers, energy devices and skin care products.

Dr. Lupo graduated summa cum laude in 1976 from Newcomb College of Tulane University, first in her graduating class. She attended Tulane University School of Medicine, completed her internship in internal medicine at Ochsner Foundation Hospital and dermatology residency at Tulane affiliated hospitals. She currently holds licensure in Louisiana and Colorado. She has lifetime certification from the American Board of Dermatology and voluntarily recertified in 2009. She is a fellow of the AAD and ASDS for which she served as member of the board of directors. She is past president of the Women's Dermatological Society and past treasurer of the Louisiana Dermatological Society. She has been named top doctor by Castle Connolly yearly since 2013 and a top dermatologist and top cosmetic doctor locally in New Orleans by Gambit Newspaper and New Orleans Magazine. Dr. Lupo is frequently quoted in beauty and lay publications such as InStyle, New Beauty and Allure. She has appeared on local TV stations as well as on E! Entertainment Network, The View and CNN news as a go-to expert in dermatology and cosmetic procedures. She is the author of more than 60 medical publications and more than 250 peer presentations.

Dr. Lupo is a frequent speaker at AAD, ASDS and various facial plastic surgery meetings both in the United States and abroad. She has been involved in several clinical trials resulting in FDA approval of products and was the investigator that launched Juvederm to Australia in 2007. Since 2005, she has acted as a founding co-director of the Cosmetic Bootcamp and since 1984 she has been a leader, innovator and mentor in filler and aesthetic education to both residents and peers through her teaching at Tulane, ASDS preceptor program, WDS mentoring program, as a trainer for filler companies, and the Cosmetic Bootcamp University. She has been a principal investigator in over 33 clinical trials.

KAVITA MARIWALLA, MD

Dr. Kavita Mariwalla is a board certified dermatologist and nationally recognized key opinion leader in dermatology and dermatologic surgery. Her expertise is in the areas of anti-aging procedures and skin cancer

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treatment. She is sought after for opinions on cosmetic formulations and is regularly invited as a featured speaker in the United States and overseas.

Prior to starting her own private practice, Dr. Mariwalla was the Director of Cutaneous Oncology at St. Luke's – Roosevelt and Beth Israel Medical Centers in New York. Dr. Mariwalla has been recognized for extensive work in the area of dermatologic education and is considered an expert injector of fillers and neuromodulators. It was received with rave reviews by both physicians and beauty editors and is constantly updated. Most recently, Dr. Mariwalla released her fourth book entitled *The Business of Dermatology*.

In addition to authoring several books, Dr. Mariwalla is editor of "Surgical Pearls" for the *Journal of the American Academy of Dermatology* and is Secretary of the American Society for Dermatologic Surgery. She has served on the Board of Directors of the Women's Dermatologic Society and American Society for Dermatologic Surgery in the past and is a three-time recipient of the ASDS President's Award for outstanding contributions to the field of dermatologic surgery. Most recently, Dr. Mariwalla received the prestigious honor of "Iron Surgeon" at the 2019 ASDS meeting.

On the national and international stage, Dr. Mariwalla is noted for sharing her injection techniques during live demonstrations at the American Academy of Dermatology annual meetings and is prolific in her writing and speaking engagements at home and abroad. Her private practice has been nominated for the "Best of Long Island," since its inception in 2012. She has also been recognized as a "Super Doctor" and "Top Doctor" by Castle Connolly for the last three years. Dr. Mariwalla earned her degree in medicine at the Yale School of Medicine where she also completed her dermatology residency and fellowship training.

He is the author and editor of the textbook *Essential Psychiatry for the Aesthetic Practitioner*, a host of *The Dermatology Show* on Sirius XM Dr. Radio, and a regularly featured expert in both print and online media.

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DARREL RIGEL, MD

Darrell S. Rigel MD MS is Clinical Professor of Dermatology at the Mount Sinai Icahn School of Medicine and is recognized as a world leader in research and patient care in melanoma and other skin cancers. He is a graduate of MIT with a BS in Management Information Sciences, an MS (MBA) from the Sloan School of Management at MIT and received his MD from George Washington University. He attended Cornell University Medical Center for Internship in Internal Medicine and completed his training at NYU where he was Resident, Chief Resident and Dermatology Surgery Fellow and was a National Institutes of Health Training Fellow.

Dr. Rigel has delivered over 1000 presentations at medical and governmental policy conferences worldwide and has chaired numerous national and international conferences and symposia. He co-chairs the Fall and Winter Clinical Dermatology Conferences. He is the author of numerous articles and abstracts in professional journals as well as lead editor of *Cancer of the Skin*, the major textbook in this field and has testified before Congress and the FDA on related issues. He often appears on National television including CNN, ABC, FOX, NBC and CBS and his research and opinions are regularly cited in the *New York Times*, *Wall Street Journal* and many other national magazines and newspapers.

Dr. Rigel serves as the Consultant Dermatologist for the New York Yankees. In addition, Dr. Rigel works with many professional and charitable organizations related to his research interests. He served as President of the American Academy of Dermatology and the American Academy of Dermatology Association and also served for 9 years as a Director of the American Board of Dermatology. He is also a Past President of the American Society for Dermatologic Surgery and the American Dermatological Association and is active in the MIT alumni program serving as a Regional Chair of the MIT Educational Counselor program.

Dr. Rigel has also received numerous awards and honors including the prestigious American Academy of Dermatology's Gold Medal – the highest award in the specialty in recognition of a lifetime of achievement, the George B. Morgan Award from MIT recognizing exceptional achievement by an alumnus and the Humanitarian Award of the Melanoma Research Foundation. He has also received the American Cancer Society's National Honor Citation for Skin Cancer Programs and multiple Presidential Citations from the Academy and American Society for Dermatologic Surgery for public education programs in skin cancer.

Dr. Rigel enjoys treating and helping improve the lives of patients with melanoma, other skin cancers, pre cancers, sun-damaged skin and high-risk moles.

NICOLE ROGERS, MD

Dr. Nicole Rogers is a fellowship-trained hair transplant surgeon and board-certified dermatologist. She and her team of highly trained technicians have successfully treated hundreds of patients with hair loss using the most cutting-edge techniques.

She graduated with honors from Harvard University and moved to New Orleans to attend Tulane Medical School. As a dermatology resident at Tulane she was chief resident and helped rebuild the training program

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after hurricane Katrina. She spent a year-long fellowship studying hair transplantation in Manhattan before returning to New Orleans to practice.

Dr. Rogers has written and spoken extensively about surgical and medical treatments for hair loss, including contemporary techniques in hair transplantation, minoxidil, finasteride, and the use of low-level light therapy for hair growth. She has co-edited two textbooks on hair transplantation, and has written numerous chapters for other textbooks on hair loss and hair transplantation. Dr. Todd Schlessinger is a board-certified dermatologist, Mohs surgeon and clinical investigator. She completed her training in dermatology at the University of Miami where she also served as chief resident.

She has dozens of publications in the medical literature with a focus on skin of color dermatology.
